### **IMPORTANT DATES AND INFORMATION**

#### **Entries Online for Live Performances**

**Sunday 5 May 2024** is the closing date for all Festival entries and Special Requests (for specific dates/times as per Appendix 4a and 4b).

**Friday 17 May 2024** is the due date for those sections which require Music Scores and Stage Plans to be submitted for entries for Live Performances.

### **Entries Electronic Recordings**

Sunday 5 May 2024 is the closing date to register Electronic Recording entries online.

Friday 17 May 2024 is the due date to submit Music Scores (for those sections required) for Electronic Recordings

Uploading of Electronic Recording (providing the URLs on the online entry) Due Date: Weds 31 July 2024

#### **ENTRIES**:

- Check your school calendar of events before entering online to avoid any conflict of days.
- <u>Do not</u> send entry fees to the Office. Invoices for entry fees will be sent to schools. The entry fee for each performance category is shown in this brochure. *Please note that entry withdrawals after invoices have been issued will still be liable for payment.*
- Entries will only be accepted through the online portal.
- Entry forms in all sections should be properly completed (i.e. name of student, name of performance, duration of performance item, section entering, student year level, number of students).
- Each entry form must be authorised by the school's Performing Arts Festival Coordinator for submission.
  The Performing Arts Festival Coordinator will be able to print out a complete list of the school's entries in
  the Festival. This list can be passed onto the Principal for his/her review. The Principal will need to
  review and acknowledge the school's acceptance of the Festival's Rules & Procedures, this is done by
  the Performing Arts Festival Coordinator (or nominee) ticking the acknowledgement box on each entry
  form online.
- Entries that do not comply with these requirements cannot be accepted.
- If music or performance item information is not received by the due date, or music, item and/or entry information is changed after the due date or on the performance day/evening, the performance will not be eligible for an Outstanding Award, Excellence Award, Merit Award or the Perpetual Shield.
- A performance that exceeds the time limit or exceeds student numbers will not be eligible for an Outstanding Award, Excellence Award, Merit Award or the Perpetual Shield.
- Special requests must be within the dates allocated for that section. This must be noted with your online entry (i.e. string ensembles can only be timetabled on days specified for string ensembles). Special Requests are taken into consideration only in extenuating circumstances and in accordance to reasons stated in Appendix 4b, however not all requests may be accommodated.
- Refer to the privacy information on the website and please ensure this information is passed on to participating students/families.
- Late withdrawals cause much inconvenience to others. If it is absolutely unavoidable that you have to withdraw from a performance, please notify the Catholic Arts Office at least one week before

performance. If a performer or group cannot attend on the performance day/evening, the Catholic Arts Office **MUST** be notified.

#### **ELIGIBILITY:**

- Students must be enrolled at a Catholic Education Western Australia Ltd systemic school at the time of performance in the Festival.
- Items selected for performance should reflect performing arts activities conducted within Catholic schools.

#### **ADJUDICATION:**

- Adjudication is the sole responsibility of the adjudicator.
- There will be no communication between teachers and the adjudicator before or during an item to be adjudicated.
- The Adjudicator's decision is final regardless of Outstanding, Excellence or Merit Awards.
- From all of the Outstanding Performances, the Performing Arts Festival Committee will select a balanced
  and entertaining programme for the Festival Concert. The Festival Concert will endeavour to reflect the
  diversity and excellence of the overall Festival within the limits set by the time available for the concert,
  the limitations set by the performance space available and the general interests of the largely family
  audience attending the concert.
- Adjudicators and the Festival Committee have the right to disqualify participants for unacceptable behaviour during the Festival and for breaches of Festival rules.
- Electronic Recording entries will receive adjudication feedback along with awards (if nominated by the Adjudicator), however, shields will not be awarded.

#### **ACCOMPANIST AND EQUIPMENT:**

- Provision of an accompanist is the responsibility of the participant.
- A piano, music stands and seating will be provided in musical sections and, where appropriate, sound and lighting equipment.
- Drum-kit and some percussion equipment will be provided for instrumental ensemble and instrumental solo/duet percussion performances.
- Bass guitar and keyboard amplifiers will be provided at the venue for instrumental solo/duet guitar performances, however, if this changes participants will be notified.
- All other musical instruments, equipment, costumes and props are to be provided by the participants.

#### TIMING AND ORDER OF PERFORMANCE:

- The Festival today is a logistically complex event. Participants can assist in the smooth running of the Festival by keeping their performances within the time limits set for each type of performance.
- The Festival organisers will attempt to formulate a running order for programmes that take into account any special circumstances however, once the programme is published, performances should proceed in the order in which the programme is published or at the discretion of the adjudicators/coordinators in special circumstances.
- Participants should wait for a signal from the adjudicator before commencing any performance.

#### **COPYRIGHT AND MUSIC COPIES FOR ADJUDICATORS:**

- All Festival performers are reminded that they are bound by laws of copyright.
- Participants and their sponsoring schools are responsible for ensuring that clearance has been obtained
  for the copying of print musical works to be performed in the Festival. Schools that are covered by an
  AMCOS licence may, however, use original scores supplemented by licensed copies for their school
  choir, band/orchestra or ensemble.
- Performers must provide adjudicators with a photocopy of the original music. This must be forwarded to the Catholic Arts Office by the specified date (refer to front of brochure for closing date). Performers should retain the original music for practice purposes and for use on the day of performance. The Adjudication copy will be destroyed after the performance.
- Any copyright questions should be directed to Lesley Joliffe, Senior Archivist, Catholic Education Western Australia Limited, ph: 9380 1918. Performers may require a licence for dubbing or public use of commercial recordings to accompany performances. Please contact Catharine McBride at APRA for further updates. - To comply with the Live Performance Category of AMCOS, schools entering the Dance section must state the title and artist of each piece of music used on the online entry.
